Mayor Ferguson welcomed public and City of Presidio staff to the special-called meeting on April 7, 2026 at the Presidio Activity Center and opened floor for any visitor to address the City Council for five minutes. Mr. John Kennedy, PMDD Director commented on the agenda item for next week. PMDD requested to have the city's approval for a flood study and an infrastructure assessment for the city. Mr. Junie Herrera commented on where we are at with the street lighting inside city limits. He also commented of the trash pollution flying around from the landfill.

DISCUSSION: Mayor Ferguson opened the floor for anyone to comment on the resolution opposing the border wall. City of Presidio public, Mayor, City Council, PMDD Director and city employees have commented their views posing the border wall. The resolution was read in Spanish.

ACTION: Councilman Montoya moved to approve and adopt Resolution 2026-03R Opposing the border wall in the Big Bend Region.

- b. **Discussion / action to adopt resolution authorizing the submission of the TDA Downtown Revitalization Program 2026 application.**

DISCUSSION: Mr. John Kennedy, PMDD Director informed the City Council of the importance of passing this resolution. This resolution is to submit the application to continue the downtown revitalization program for an addition \$1,000,000 with an additional \$100,000 match.

ACTION: Councilwoman Martinez-Bailon moved to approve and adopt Resolution 2026-04R authorizing the City Administrator the submission of the TDA Downtown Revitalization Program 2026 application with keeping the optional verbage of the Downtown District Designation in paragraph 1, and select the first option for paragraph 2. Councilman Montoya seconded the motion.
